NARRATIVE						
<p>EMS was called for an 86-year old male experiencing dizziness and weakness. Upon arrival, patient was lying on the bed. Patient was alert and able to answer questions, but was very weak and diaphoretic. An adult assessment was done and patient vitals were assessed including glucose and temperature. Patient's spouse said that he had been feeling this way for about a week. SAMPLE was gathered from the patient's spouse. Patient had crackles on the lower right side of his lungs. O2 sats were 78 on room air. Patient put on 15L O2 via NRB. Patient was moved to a seated position but he became very dizzy so he was laid back down. Patient was moved and secured to the stretcher. Patient moved to the ambulance. Vitals were re-assessed while en route. IV was established in patient's left AC and patient given 200ml LR on a 20-gauge needle. Patient continued on 15L O2 via NRB. Patient report was called in to the hospital. Patient condition re-assessed while en route. Patient showed improvements in O2 saturations, but pulse remained high and patient was still diaphoretic. Patient denied any chest pain. Patient was transported to Sevier Valley Medical Center and patient care turned over to the ER staff.</p>
